# Florida Theological Seminary

## DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

1. We believe the Scriptures of the Old Testament and New Testament are verbally inspired by God, and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life. (Matt. 5:18; John 10:35; 2 Tim. 3:16; 1 Pet. 1:21)
2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deut. 6:4; 1 Cor. 8:6; Col. 2:9; Acts 4:3-5)
3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man. (Luke 1:35; Matt. 1:18, 25; John 5:18; Luke 2:52)
4. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also that spiritual death which is separation from God. (Gen. 1:26, 27; 2:7; 3:6,7; Rom. 5:12-21)
5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all that believe in Him are justified on the grounds of his shed blood. (2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Tim. 2:6; Rom. 3:24, 25; 5:1; 1 John 2:2; 1 Pet. 2:24)
6. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into heaven, and His present life for us, as High Priest and Advocate. (Matt. 28:7, John 21:13, 14; Acts 1:9; Heb. 7:25; Rom. 8:34; 1 John 2:1)
7. We believe in “The Blessed Hope,” the personal pre-millennial and imminent return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (1 Thess. 4:13-18; 1 Cor. 15:51, 52; Titus 2:13; Rev. 20:4-6; 1 Thess. 1:10)
8. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and unjust, the everlasting felicity of the saved and the everlasting conscious suffering of the lost. (Dan. 12:2; John 5:29; Matt. 25:46; Luke 16:19-31; Rev. 20:4-6, 11-15)
9. We value the worth and dignity of all persons as created in the image of God. We affirm the priesthood of all believers and the responsibility of every Christian woman and man to take an active role in edifying the Church. For that purpose, the Holy Spirit distributes ministry gifts to believers without distinction of any kind. That reality imposes the responsibility on every believer to fulfill ministry consistent with God’s grace. (Gen. 1:27; Gal. 3:28; Rom. 12:5-6a; 1 Cor. 12:1-11; Eph. 2:10; 2 Cor. 9:8)
10. We distinguish between ministry functions and church office. While upholding the necessity of mutual respect and affirmation as those subject to the Word of God, understanding that the biblical office of elder/pastor in the early church was gender specific. Therefore it maintains that it is consistent with that understanding of Scripture that those church offices should be limited to the male gender. (Eph. 4:11; 1 Tim. 3:1-2, Titus 1:7-9)

# ADMISSIONS

Florida Theological Seminary and Bible College's courses of study are designed in such a way as to provide graceful growth, starting with the certificate level and continuing through the doctorate level. We offer academic programs that lead to Certificates; Associate of Arts degrees; Bachelor of Science degrees in Biblical Studies, Christian Education, Biblical Exposition, and Theology; Master of Art Degrees in Biblical Studies and Christian Education; Master's Degree in Theology and Doctorate of Ministry.

We at Florida Theological Seminary value the worth and dignity of all persons as created in the image of God. We affirm the priesthood of all believers and the responsibility of every Christian man and woman to take an active role in edifying the Church. For that purpose, the Holy Spirit distributes ministry gifts to believers without distinction of any kind. That reality imposes the responsibility on every believer to fulfill ministry consistent with God's grace. (Gen 1:27; Gal 3:28; Rom 12:5-6a; 1 Cor 12:1-11; Eph 2:10; 2 Cor 9:8)

Florida Theological Seminary distinguishes between ministry function and church office. While upholding the necessity of mutual respect and affirmation as those subject to the Word of God, Florida Theological Seminary understands that the biblical office of elder/pastor in the early church was gender specific. Therefore it maintains that it is consistent with that understanding of Scripture that those church offices should be limited to the male gender. Consequently pastoral/preaching curriculum/courses are offered to males only. (Eph 4:11; 1 Tim 3:1-2; Titus 1:7-9)

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Application for admission may be made at any time. To be admitted, all prospective students are required to complete the Application for Admission Form and mail it with the applicable documents and fees to the Seminary.

For students applying for the Adult Bible Studies Program there is no academic requirement to enter, just an honest desire to study and learn God's Word. However, before the student can enter any Certificate, Associate of Arts or Bachelor's Degree program, the student must possess a high school diploma, or GED.

Students applying for any of the Certificate or Degree Programs must provide a high school diploma, or a GED, and arrange for transcripts from any previously attended college or seminary to be sent to Florida Theological Seminary

### EVALUATION OF CREDIT FOR MINISTERIAL EXPERIENCE

Pastors can receive 10 to 20 credit hours depending on years of pastoral experience. Those who are seeking Masters or Doctorate degree will be allowed to obtain 15 credits hours by completing a thesis or dissertation.

### TRANSFER CREDITS

Florida Theological Seminary and Bible College will accept transfer credits received from other Theological and secular schools subject to review and evaluation by the officers of Florida Theological Seminary and Bible College.

The transfer of credits to another institution is at the discretion of the accepting institution, and it is the student's responsibility to confirm whether or not credits will be accepted by the institution of the student's choice.

\*Note: All transcripts must be mailed to Florida Theological Seminary directly from student's former school(s).
